

Core learning:

The Parable of the Talents

‘For it is as if a man, going on a journey,
summoned his slaves and entrusted his property to them;
to one he gave five talents, to another two,
to another one, to each according to his ability.

Then he went away.

The one who had received the five talents
went off at once and traded with them,
and made five more talents.

In the same way,
the one who had the two talents
made two more talents.
But the one who had received the one talent
went off and dug a hole in the ground
and hid his master’s money.

The Parable of the Talents

After a long time the master of those slaves came and settled accounts with them.

Then the one who had received the five talents came forward, bringing five more talents, saying, "Master, you handed over to me five talents; see, I have made five more talents."



In pairs, talk about your ideas of working together for the good of all in your class, school, parish, and community.




