the first day.




And God said,

the second day.





And God saw that it was good.






Then God said,

Six Days of Creation and the Sabbath

And God said,

And God saw that it was good.



the sixth day.




Six Days of Creation and the Sabbath

and all their multitude.


And on the seventh day

when they were created.




