

The following list is just to illustrate that God has always been active and present throughout human history.


This is known as Salvation History and reaches Fulfillment in Jesus, the Son of God and the Son of Mary.

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



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Easter Triduum

is the beginning of prayer.



Core learning:
Having read the words of Isaiah (Isaiah 42: 1-9),
I recognise God as a loving creator and a God of justice.

The Servant, a Light to the Nations

Here is my servant, whom I uphold,
my chosen, in whom my soul delights;
I have put my spirit upon him;
he will bring forth justice to the nations.

He will not cry or lift up his voice,
or make it heard in the street;
a bruised reed he will not break,
and a dimly burning wick he will not quench;
he will faithfully bring forth justice.
He will not grow faint or be crushed
until he has established justice in the earth;
and the coastlands wait for his teaching.

Thus says God, the Lord,

the Holy Spirit to guide you.


Core learning: I know that the Holy Spirit strengthens my faith,

and decorate it.


Pray it often

guidance.

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
On feast days of saints and in your RE lessons, look out for signs that the Holy Spirit inspired saints to be loving, kind and to spread the Gospel of Jesus.
